THANK GOD I'M FREE

"...as always, so now also Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether it be by life, or by death. For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain." Philippians 1:20-21

The Apostle Paul lived a most extraordinary life. How did he live such a life? In these verses, Paul declared the source of his living to be Jesus Christ. This is not about imitation, far from it; it's about a total transformation! That is exactly what had occurred in Paul's life. Paul said that the reason Christ was so evident in his life was because it actually was Christ; Christ was living in Paul. Paul had been transformed! According to Paul, the only way for him to live was by means of Christ. Christ is The Life-the only life (John 14:6). That is why only Christ living in you, is the answer to your life. Real living is Christ living!

Are you living or just existing? If you are allowing Christ to live His life in you, then you are living. Otherwise, you're just existing. As you allow Christ to do the living, He will be magnified in your body: through life as well as death. When something is magnified, it becomes evident for all to see. You see the difference and so will everyone else. They will be able to see Christ-His character and His conduct-expressed through you. And the beauty of it is, you get to enjoy His life! Now that is living an extraordinary life and you are Free to do so!

CONGREGATIONAL BUSINESS MEETING

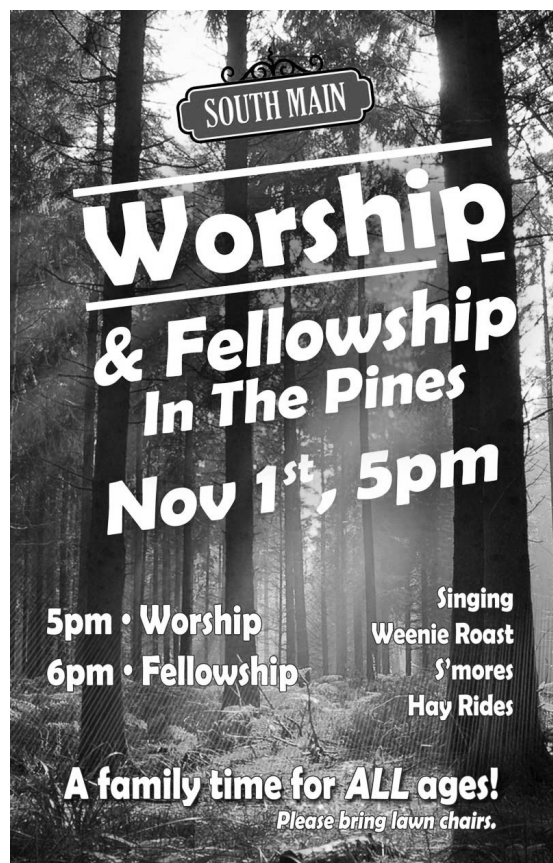
