THE SIMPLE LIFE

"But I am afraid that, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, your minds will be led astray from the simplicity and purity of devotion to Christ."

2 Corinthians 11:3

The apostle Paul used the marriage illustration to describe our new relationship with Christ. Being in Christ, means your life is joined with Him through spiritual rebirth - married, as it were, to Jesus Christ in a Divine union. Paul said that we should be as a "chaste virgin" toward Christ, which in this case is one who remains pure, with singular devotion and settled dependency upon Him. But we are so easily drawn away, looking to other things to meet our needs, or looking to other people for our significance and fulfillment. How does this happen? Paul tells us that the Serpent is very crafty and devious. His strategy is to lead us astray and corrupt our thinking. Such mind games can be confusing and misleading. There is a distinct contrast between being Heavenly-minded and being Earthly -minded. A Heavenly-minded person is focused on the Lord and His will. Being Earthly-minded means a focus upon the things of this world that take away from our focus on Christ

There are always distractions in life, which can make things extremely complicated. But it doesn't have to be that way! Christ comes to simplify our life. To give us a single-minded focus. That within itself makes life simple. He gives us purpose and hope for each new day. He renews us with the strength of hope in His resurrection, knowing that we too shall be partakers of the same in the final day. The Simple life! Life "in Christ".
