BOB'S THOUGHTS...

GREAT FAITH

"Lord, trouble not yourself: for I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof: but say in a word and my servant will be healed. For I also am a man set under authority, ... when Jesus heard these things, He marveled at him, ... and said to the people, ..."I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel."

Luke 7:6-9

A prominent Roman soldier came to the Lord Jesus on behalf of his servant. He appealed to the Lord in humility, admitted his unworthiness, and acknowledged the Lord's supreme authority over all things. Then he yielded to the Lord's prerogative by making a simple request, "Lord, if you will, just say the word and my servant will be healed." He got it! The Lord Jesus marveled in amazement at the simple, yet profound faith of this Roman soldier. In fact, He declared that this man had exhibited great faith! Furthermore, his faith was greater than any Jesus had found in all of Israel. For the Lord to say that about him was quite an honor! This man's faith was great because he placed it totally and completely in the great and mighty one - Jesus Christ the Lord! The object of our faith always determines the size of our faith.

How great is your faith? What will the Lord say about you? If we just take the approach that this Roman soldier did, then our lives will change! We must place our total and complete trust in the Lord Jesus Christ - not just occasionally or partially, but trust Him totally and completely for everything. Make Jesus the object of your faith and you can't go wrong. Simply approach the Lord in humility, admit your unworthiness, and acknowledge His supreme authority in your life. Then, rely upon Him to meet all of your needs. Wait expectantly upon Him and leave the results to Him. The outcome: you will be a person of great faith, and God will be glorified!
