BOB'S THOUGHTS...

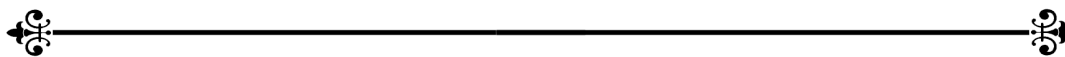
HIS PURPOSE

“And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are called according to His purpose.” Romans 8:28

“It all works out!” But the question is, how does it work out? It either works out for good or for evil, for better or for worse. That depends upon whether you are living according to God’s purpose or not, because all things only work together for good according to His purpose. God has a purpose in everything! His higher purpose is always for your good and for HIS GLORY. Therefore, when you start with God, it can’t be anything but good for you. Furthermore, all things only work together for good to “the called.” So, who are the called? “The called” are those whom God has called. God issued the call to whosoever would believe in Jesus Christ (John 3:16). God calls us to Himself: into a relationship with Him through Jesus Christ. Jesus personally extended the call when He said, “Come unto me, all you who labor and are heavy laden”(Matthew 11:28). Tragically, although many are called, only a few are chosen. Why? Because all too few heed the call.

So, how is it working out for you? If you want things to work out right, you must submit to God’s purpose and go God’s way with your life. The prerequisite to all things working out for your good is that you must love God; you must have a love relationship. It is not enough just to say you love God. Loving God is a matter of heart. Genuine love originates in your heart and is expressed through your life. You must love God with your total being: all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength. Love involves action, resulting in the works of God. This is His purpose.
