DAVID'S THOUGHTS..

Answer this question in your head: "Where are you today?"

Now reflect on that answer with me a minute. There are couple of ways to accurately answer that question. First, you may have responded in physical terms such as in Henderson or at the church building. Secondly, you may have answered in social terms such as in a dysfunctional family or in my company's management. Both your social and physical location can have a dramatic impact on you and those around you. It's also something we need to consider when we think about our Christian lives.

Did you consider one set of answers and not another or did you think about both? Which one did you consider first?

When we interact with God through worship, prayer, song or study, just changing our "location" can make a huge difference. Try reading the story of Genesis outside at dawn. Try singing and worshipping in the midst of hundreds of people. Try praying at different buildings all around the city.

Similarly, changing your "social" location, although often more difficult, can also dramatically affect your time with God. Have you ever worshiped God when you owned absolutely nothing? Prayed to Him when you feared for your life? Remember what worship was like when you were a child?

Sharing the message of Jesus and our salvation can also have a different impact by simply changing our location. Preaching to poverty-stricken people living in Africa is much different than preaching to middle-class Texans. And simply taking the message to others instead of expecting them to come to the message can make all the difference in eternity.

I challenge you stop and think about where you are and where God wants you to be.
