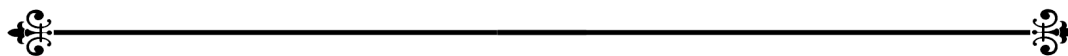
## THE EYES OF UNDERSTANDING

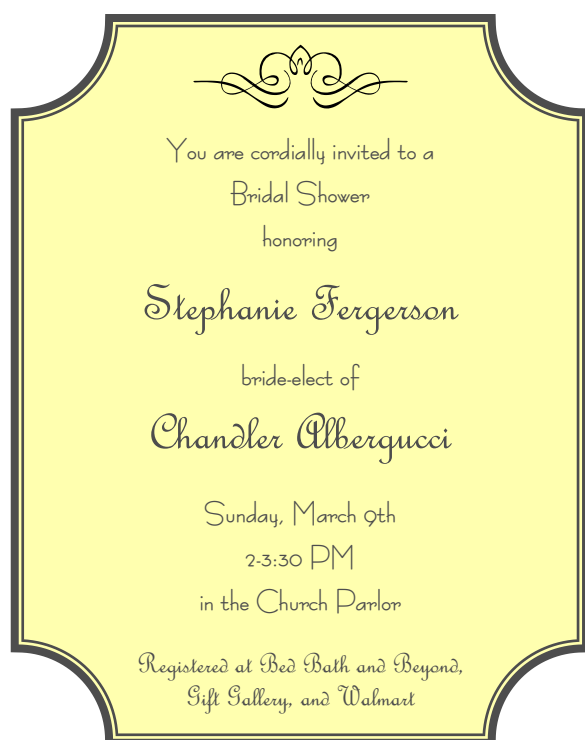
### ACAPPELLA CLASSIC

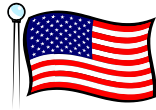
