BOB'S THOUGHTS...

DOUBTING THOMAS

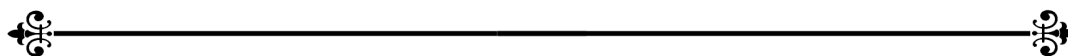
But Thomas...said unto them, except I shall see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into His side, I will not believe. And after eight days...came Jesus... and said to Thomas, reach out your finger, and behold my hands; and reach out your hand and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing .

John 20:24-27.

This is the account of “doubting Thomas,” or so he’s been called, but not by Jesus. Jesus didn’t label him, or fault him for having doubts. Instead, Jesus encouraged Thomas to believe on Him. Jesus even singled Thomas out and made a special point of addressing his reservations. Then, Jesus exhorted Thomas to cease being faithless and start believing. Prior to Jesus’ arrival, Thomas had indicated that he was willing to believe. He just needed to be sure that it was really Jesus. The moment Thomas experienced that personal encounter with Jesus, he had no doubts. Thomas went from faithless, to believing.

Faith is a personal matter. Therefore, it’s something that you must come to grips with personally. It cannot be your husband’s faith or your wife’s nor can it be anyone else’s faith. It must be your own personal faith. You have the capacity to believe. The question is, do you believe? To the extent that you are not exercising your faith, you are faithless. It’s time to let go of your doubts and start believing. You need to start exercising your faith and taking action upon your belief. Are you ready to be faithful and not faithless? Why not express like Thomas, “My Lord and My God.”

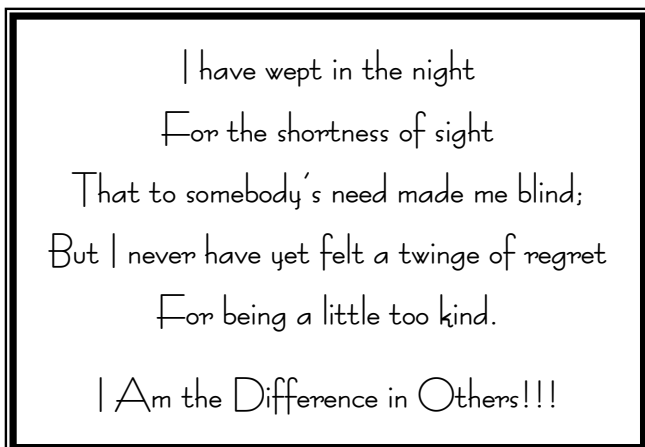
ARMS OF HOPE GROCERY TRUCK
