Bob's Thoughts...

JESUS IS LORD

“Why call me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things that I say? Therefore, whoever hears these sayings of mine, and does them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock.”

Luke 6:46, Matt. 7:24

Jesus Christ is the rock: solid, unbreakable, and unshakeable! He’s the sure foundation upon which to build your life. He is the Lord of Lords! This is where it often breaks down. Most Christians readily accept Christ as Lord of their past, with all its sins, faults, and failures in order that they can be forgiven.
