## David's Thoughts...

Solomon is famous for praying for wisdom. Moses is less so, but he seems to have had a better understanding of how God imparted that wisdom. In Psalms 90:12 (NET) he prayed, "Teach us to consider our mortality, so that we may live wisely." It seems that understanding our time on earth is short is a prerequisite for true wisdom. It is only when we realize we are lost and dying that we may appreciate salvation and life. Paul echoes this in 2 Corinthians 7:9 saying, "I now rejoice...that you were made sorrowful to the point of salvation." Eternal joy necessarily follows mortal despair. As one 1960's rock band put it, "You got to go through Hell to get to Heaven."

When we don't have a firm grasp on our mortality, we begin to believe we are invincible. We buy into the "I Can Do It All" religion that preaches self-reliance and self-determination, conveniently forgetting the second half of Philippians 4:13. In a comfortable 21st-Century America, we are guilty of this much more often than we care to admit.

So what can we do to remind ourselves of our reliance on God and gain wisdom? Let's do what Moses suggested and consider our own mortality. Here are some suggested conversation starters with a friend or loved one:

Discuss how people will remember you at your funeral.

List the times you were keenly aware of how fragile your life is.

Read James 4:14 and discuss how it speaks to you.

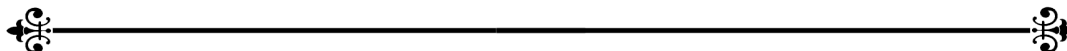
What major life decision would you have made differently if you had been dying when you made it?

How would your life change if you knew you had just 30 days to live?

The Next Step: Together with your loved one(s), commit to pray for wisdom every day for the next seven days. And don't forget to share with each other the results of your prayers. Then ask God to put someone in your life this week that needs the urgent message of God's Gospel. Then watch out and be ready, because God answers prayers!
