# Bob's Thoughts...

## DOING THE WILL OF GOD

*"I delight to do your will, O my God: yes, your law is within my heart."*  
Psalm 40:8

This verse describes Jesus Christ upon His coming to the earth. It also describes Jesus Christ upon His coming into our lives. What is the significance of this for us today? Plenty! When Christ comes into our lives, our perspective on God, His Word, His will, and His law are totally changed. This is explained beautifully in Hebrews 10:5-22. Just as Psalm 40:8 became true when Christ came into the world, it also becomes true about us when Christ comes into our lives. Once that happens, God's law is written upon our hearts. It's imbedded within us, so that we want what God wants. Christ now indwells us in order that we might do the will of God. Doing the will of God becomes assisted by Christ working through us. Furthermore, it becomes a delight to do His will!

Doing the will of God is not about conformity to an external standard of rules and regulations. God is not interested in religious rituals such as sacrifices, offerings or Christian disciplines. Just because you achieve a form of godliness does not mean it is true godliness. What God is looking for is an available vessel - a body wholly yielded to Him. That means that you must present your body to the Lord as a living sacrifice, so that Christ can live through you. Submit your will to His will. As a new creation you have a new heart, a heart after God! Therefore, you delight in doing God's will and this will delight the Lord!
