INSTRUMENTS OF RIGHTEOUSNESS

“Yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God.” Romans 6:13

Yield! It's easier said than done. Yielding involves giving up our rights, and giving ourselves to God. But why should we yield? Yielding is our God-given privilege. We are not our own; we've been bought with a price. What price? Jesus Christ paid the price for our lives when He offered Himself as a sacrifice upon the cross. He gave His life for us, in order that we might have life eternal. We are all spiritually dead in sin; separated from God because of sin and, therefore, in need of life. 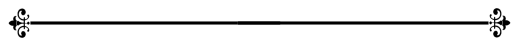
VBS
