# Bob's Thoughts...

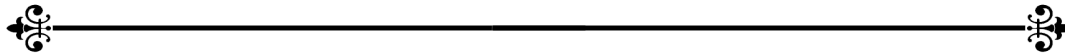
## UNITED WE STAND

*"For two, says He, shall be one flesh. But he that is joined to the Lord is one spirit."  
- 1 Corinthians 6:16-17*

Solidarity! In a shakable, breakable world where there is so much division and strife, we desperately need solidarity. People everywhere are constantly looking for ways to "form a more perfect union." They're always trying to find something we have in common to unite us: a common creed, conviction, cause, philosophy, religion, goal, or even enemies. Humans will use anything in an attempt to bring themselves together. And together we must be, or divided we will fall! We need something to bring us together and keep us together. However, regardless of what is used, it never truly unites us. The reason being, there is no perfect union... at least not on the human plane. But there is a perfect union on the Divine plane! On the human plane all mankind is separated from God, and thus from one another. 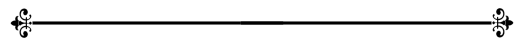
