BOB'S THOUGHTS...

SANCTIFIED

Saints, one and all! The sacrificial death of Jesus Christ makes sinners into saints. This is the promise of the new birth. The will of God was that the Son of God would offer the perfect sacrifice whereby we could be sanctified. Thank God, Jesus Christ was willing and He did just that. Therefore, "in Christ" we have been sanctified! Set apart by God, yes, but oh, so much more. We have been made holy through union with Christ - the holy one of God. Not only that, but we are indwelt by the Holy Spirit so that we might live a holy life. Thus, the most common name for Christians in the New Testament is saints.

When you put on Christ, you are converted - changed from a sinner to a saint. This is an amazing work of God and a marvelous gift from the Father to you. In Christ you are the best that you can be, which is just perfect. Jesus Christ is your perfection! He has made you holy in Him, not by any works of righteousness that you have done, but by the single sacrificial offering of himself on the cross. Christ makes you perfect on the inside in order that you might express that perfection on the outside. So stop trying to improve on perfection. You can't do it! Start living out of the perfection of your inner man in union with Christ rather than the imperfections of your outer man. Simply allow the indwelling Holy Spirit to manifest His holiness through you. Then you will be living like a saint! That's what sanctification is all about.
