DAVID'S THOUGHTS..

MORE ON MOORE

They say lightning doesn't strike in the same place twice. But “they” have never been to Moore, Oklahoma. On May 20th, 2013 a mile-and-a-half-wide, EF-5 tornado drove its way across the Oklahoma City suburb, killing 23 people and injuring nearly 400. More than 1,500 homes were destroyed and more than \$2 billion of damage left in its wake. Eerily, the tornado tracked, almost exactly, the path of a similar EF-5 tornado that brought even more death and destruction to Moore in 1999. That one contained 300-mph winds, the highest ever measured on the face of the earth and recovery lasted for months. Recovery from this one is likely to take even longer.

Several churches in the area have, once again, stepped up to help both Christians and non-Christians find food, shelter and long-term recovery help. The Central Church of Christ's building sits less than a block north of the path of the tornado. It was damaged, but survived. It now serves as a hub, with church members and other volunteers handing out hundreds of meals every day.

During his last week, while with his disciples in Jerusalem, Jesus tried to equip his followers for the difficult times ahead (Matt 25). The times when his band of believers would have to help each other in love in order to survive. We still live in those times. And we still need each other—our brothers and sisters in Christ—to survive when the storms come, both spiritually and physically.

Today we will take up a collection for those still suffering the destructive effects of the tornado that stuck Moore, Oklahoma just a few weeks ago. The money will be sent to the Central Church of Christ to be used for their own families that lost their homes and those in their community who have nowhere else to turn. Let's all have a part in helping so that the words of Matt 25:40 may ring true, “The King will reply, ‘Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.’”

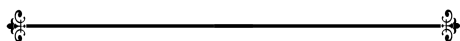

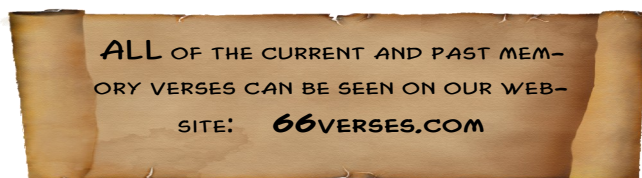
